


Directions:

What range of services does Maryland Urgent Care provide?

How do I make an appointment?

Call 301-277-3555 from 8am to 7pm, Monday through Friday.

How do I become a patient?

You can obtain registration forms from our website at <http://www.mdicare.com/beourpatient.html>. After completing the forms, please fax them to us at 301-552-0098. Our receptionist will phone you to schedule an appointment.

What do I need to bring to complete my immigration physical exam?

You will need to complete 1) a simple registration form, 2) your immunization record, and 3) a photocopy of your passport page bearing your USA visa or I-94.

After completing the physical exam, the necessary tests, and immunizations, your forms will be ready in 48 hours.

How is payment for Maryland Urgent Care handled?

Immigration physicals and travel vaccines are not covered by regular insurance plans, a cash or credit card payment is made at the time of delivery of service.

Appointments and services for other reasons: regular physicals and walk up and regular medical appointments that are covered by regular insurances are billed. We accept all PPO, POS plans and most regular insurances.

We also have a sliding fee schedule for non-insured individuals.

What do I do if I have an emergency?

If you have a serious problem that can't wait until the clinic is open, call 301-277-3555 and follow the prompts. You will be able to speak directly with an on-call physician. Sometimes it is necessary to leave a message with your contact number and the on-call physician will be paged.

What happens if my illness requires hospital care?

In that case, the on-call physician will arrange for your admission at one of the hospitals that our physicians have privileges at, to ensure continuity of care.

What age should I be to become a patient?

We see infants from age 6 months and above. If the medical condition requires a specialist referral, we will promptly make the arrangements, so that your needs are taken care of.
